Dr. E Stanley Jones, Missionary for Peace and Brotherhood

Dr. E Stanley Jones (1884-1973) was a missionary who became a spokesman for peace, brotherhood and social justice throughout the world. Living out his life and service predominantly in India, he was called by a prominent Bishop "The greatest missionary since St Paul." He was twice nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize for his work in the area of racial justice. He authored thirty books and founded the Christian Ashrams (forest retreats) in India and throughout the world. His devotion to Jesus led him to value and respect people of many faiths, races, and nationalities.
