## Artist Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in supporting the Journey Center's Art Gallery and our work in the community, and especially for donating art for our annual 6x6 Small Art Exhibition! Please read both pages of these guidelines carefully. We will accept up to 300 pieces of art that meet these simple criteria... and we would LOVE to have your work in the show!

- 1. Each artist may donate 1- 4 pieces of art to the Exhibition. (If this is being organized as a classroom project, please choose up to a total of 4 pieces from the class's work to donate to the show).
- 2. Every piece donated *must be exactly 6 inches x 6 inches*. If the piece is smaller, then it should be mounted on a mat or support that is exactly 6x6.
- 3. Art can be created in any medium and may be 2D or 3D.
- 4. We have only these few restrictions- thank you!:
  - no violent or sexual art (we are a spirituality center and hold safe, peaceful space for those who visit us)
  - no glitter
  - no unfixed charcoal
  - no unfixed pastel
  - no frames, please
  - do NOT sign your work on the front, only on the back- the pieces are being offered anonymously and the artist's identity is revealed only after the piece is purchased... ☺
- 5. Print and fill out one Artwork Entry Form (*both* the OFFICE and BUYER copy) *for each piece of art* that you are donating to the 6x6 Small Art Exhibition. On the buyer copy, please include any information that you want them to have.
- 6. Finished work, ready for mounting, and the Artwork Entry Form(s) should be dropped off at (or mailed to):

  The Journey Center, 1601 Fourth Street, Santa Rosa, CA 95404, Monday through Wednesday, September 12-14, between 10 a.m.- 4 p.m. Other drop-off times are possible please contact the Journey Center to arrange this.

- 8. *The preview week* is Monday-Thursday, September 19-22 (10 a.m.-4 p.m.) and Friday, September 23 (6-7 p.m.). *The 6x6 Fundraiser Event and Art Sale* is Friday, September 23 (7-8 p.m.). Raffle tickets will be sold on Friday, September 23 at 7 p.m. to give 10 lucky people the opportunity to be the first into the gallery to choose the pieces they will purchase.
